Some of the key assignments handled by Vishrov are:

- Represented Sasan Power, GMR, GVK and RattanIndia in change in law matters before Central and State Electricity Regulatory Commissions. The CERC Orders in change in law are precedent-setting on the basis of which subsequent change in law claims have been allowed by various Regulatory Commissions.
- Represented Association of Power Producers and several power companies in proceedings before the Hon'ble Supreme Court challenging the 12th February RBI Circular which was ultimately quashed. This was the first instance of an RBI Circular being quashed.
